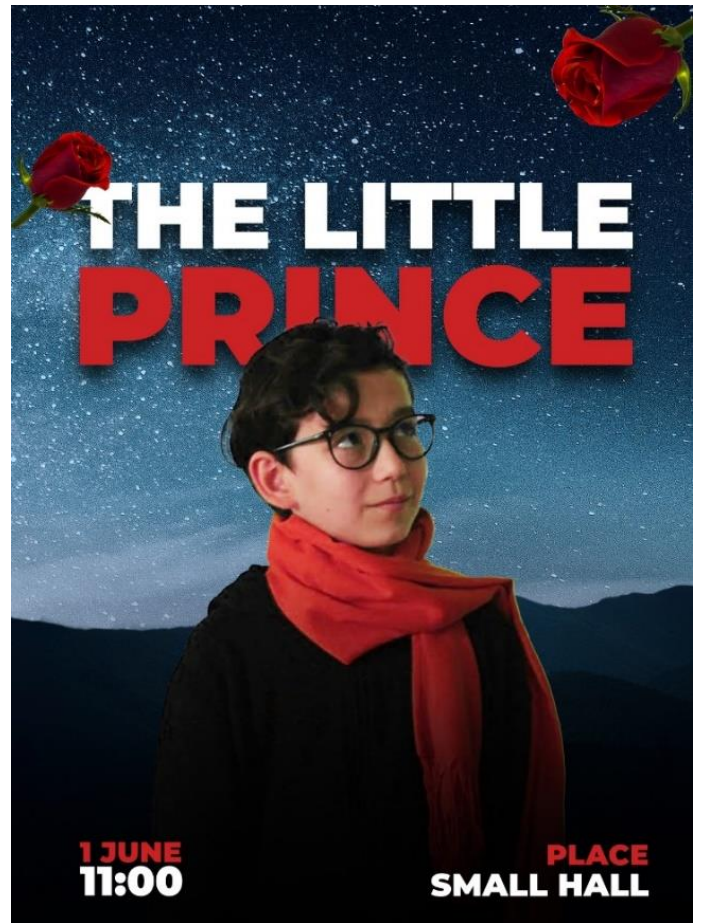


## "THE LITTLE PRINCE" THEATRICAL PERFORMANCE

## ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING: “ALTYN KAZYK” EDUCATION TRANSFORMATION PROGRAM

On May 22nd, 2024, the Advisory Council met at BIS to discuss Kyrgyzstan's transformative “Alтын Kazyk” education program. Chaired by Ambassador Olivier Bangerter, the meeting included updates on BIS developments and plans for new school sites. Also for this meeting we invited the Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Education and Science of Kyrgyz Republic - Lira Samykbaeva, who told us about the “Alтын Kazyk” program.

Lira Samykbaeva introduced the “Alтын Kazyk” Program, outlining significant reforms in Kyrgyzstan’s education sector. The Alтын Kazyk



program includes areas such as moving to a 12 year education system, strengthening preschool education, introducing the best textbooks in the natural sciences and English language based on the Cambridge program, and digitalization in education. She talked about Google supporting the Alтын Kazyk program to transform the school education system. Many questions from Advisory Council members led to a lively discussion of the planned reforms.
