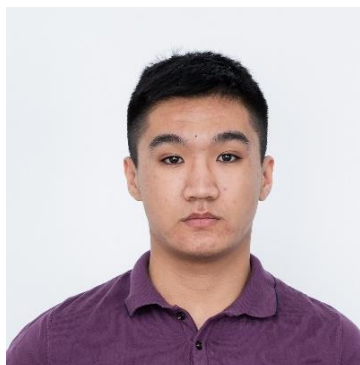
Gulsana Niizbek kyzy

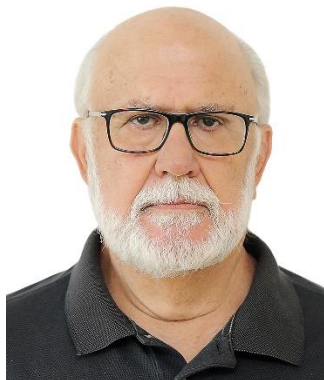

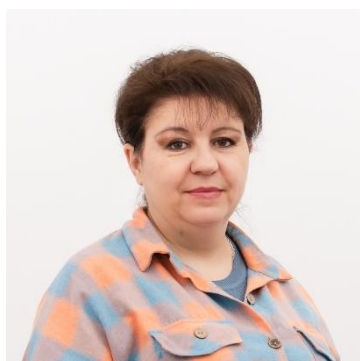
